THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 4, 2006, in the Eastern District of Tennessee, the defendant, JAMES LYNN CARR, did knowingly wear decorations and medals authorized by Congress for the armed forces of the United States, and service medals and badges awarded to the members of such forces, and the ribbon, button, and rosette of such badge, decoration and medal, and a colorable imitation thereof, while not authorized under regulations made pursuant to law.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 704.
