



Title: (Chapter 07) UNDESIRABLE CONDUCT AND PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Giving a deposition, affidavit or appearing as a witness in a civil matter stemming from one's official duties as a Department member without the knowledge of the Sheriff of Hamilton County.

b. Rendering Aid/Furnishing Identification:

Failure to render aid or furnish information as is consistent with one's duty. To this end, a Department member/employee shall furnish one's name and badge number in a respectful manner when so requested.

c. Recovered Property/Evidentiary Material:

Failure to turn over to the designated agent of the Department all lost, stolen, recovered, abandoned or evidentiary material which comes into the possession of a Department member as a result of the performance of Departmental duties. To this end, all such material shall be turned over prior to the completion of the tour of duty during which the material came into the possession of the member of the Department.

d. Fees/Rewards:

Acceptance or receipt of any fee or reward from any source for any services rendered in the line of duty without the knowledge and written consent of the Sheriff of Hamilton County.

e. Department Property-Loss/Damage - Negligence/Inattention:

Loss/damage to Department property due to negligence or inattention to duty.

f. Loss of Department Property/Equipment - Reporting:

Failure to promptly report to the Sheriff or his designated agent the loss of any Department property/equipment that has been furnished to the individual.

g. Serving as Character Witness:

Giving testimony as a character witness for any defendant in a criminal trial without the knowledge and approval of the Sheriff.

h. Knowledge of Laws/Rules and Regulations/Policies and Procedures/General and Specific Orders:

Failure to establish and maintain a working knowledge of laws, policies and procedures, rules and regulations, general and special orders.
