CONTEST RULES

- **Who can enter:** Any elementary school student in grades 1-5.
- **Deadline:** Entries must be received at the Times Free Press by 5 p.m. Friday, Nov. 21.
- **Grand prize:** \$25, family memberships to the Hunter Museum of American Art and Creative Discovery Museum, and your picture and Christmas design printed as wrapping paper in the newspaper. The winner will be contacted no later than Nov. 27.
- **Finalist prizes:** Six finalists will win Times Free Press T-shirts.
- **Judges:** The Times Free Press design staff and representatives from Allied Arts and Kids on the Block will select the winners.
- **Entry format:** Use an 8½- by 11-inch piece of unlined paper. One entry per child. Each entry should have the child's name, age, address, telephone number and school printed on the back. (A teacher's name is also helpful.)
