**ORDER ALLOWING TRUSTEE TO TEMPORARILY OPERATE BUSINESS OF
DEBTOR AND SCHEDULING HEARING**

This matter is before the Court upon the Motion of Jerrold D. Farinash, Trustee, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 721 to operate the Debtor's business on a temporary basis pending a hearing by the Court after notice and an opportunity to be heard to allow for further operation of the Debtor's business. It appearing to the Court that the same is proper and necessary, the Trustee is authorized to operate the business of the Debtor, on a temporary basis, through and including March 31, 2009. A hearing is scheduled for March 5, 2009, at 10:30 a.m. in Bankruptcy Courtroom A, Third Floor, Historic United States Courthouse, 31 East 11th Street, Chattanooga, Tennessee for the Court to consider allowing the Trustee to operate the Debtor's business beyond March 31, 2009.

The Trustee shall serve this Order together with the Motion on all creditors and parties in interest. This Order shall constitute Notice of the Hearing.
