Re: Data and Cost Analysis

Gentlemen:

In order for the City's Public Works staff to perform the analysis on the sewer collection system the following data and information will be required:

1. The most recent breakdown of commercial and residential customers including a listing of all multi unit residences where more than a single unit served by one water meter, providing the number of units served and account number of water supplier;
2. A listing of all overflows and or stoppages within the City limits of Red Bank during the past 48 months giving date, location, volume, duration and cause of overflow or stoppage;
3. A listing of sewer repairs and any I & I corrections performed during the last 48 months;
4. An inventory of all sewer lines by size and type of material and all manholes by size and types of material;
5. An inventory of non PVC sewer lines, connections and private laterals;
6. Copies of all available CCTV inspection tapes of sewer lines;
7. Copies of all Notices of Violation (NOV) issued by TEDC during the past five (5) years;
8. A listing of all anticipated, planned or projected sewer line replacements, overflow corrections, etc., including any engineers' cost projections and time tables;


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9. A listing of all sewer line cleaning performed during the last 48 months, providing dates, feet of line cleaned, and a statement of the condition of the segment cleaned if CCTVed;
10. Any projected fees assessments or other cost payable to or from HCWWTA upon leaving he HCWWTA and the legal basis for imposition of any such fees, charges or assessments:
11. Sewer rehabilitation inventory, five (5) years and six (6) months.
