**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about January 12, 2009, in the Eastern District of Tennessee and elsewhere, GARY EDWARD SALLES knowingly transported child pornography, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 2256(8), in interstate commerce by means of a computer, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(1).

**COUNT TWO**

The Grand Jury further charges that from in or about January 2008 until January 2009, in the Eastern District of Tennessee and elsewhere, the defendants, GARY EDWARD SALLES and MICKEY LEONARD LATTIMORE, and others known and unknown, did combine, conspire, confederate and agree to knowingly, intentionally, and without authority violate Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), that is, to distribute and possess with the intent to distribute five (5) grams or more of methamphetamine or fifty (50) grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 846 and 841(b)(1)(B).

**COUNT THREE**

The Grand Jury further charges that on or about January 17, 2009, in the Eastern District of Tennessee, the defendants, GARY EDWARD SALLES and MICKEY LEONARD LATTIMORE, aided and abetted by each other, did knowingly, intentionally, and without authority possess with the intent to distribute a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, a Schedule II controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

**COUNT FOUR**

The Grand Jury further charges that on or about January 17, 2009, in the Eastern District of Tennessee and elsewhere, GARY EDWARD SALLES did knowingly transport child pornography, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 2256(8), in interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(1).
