On 08-14-2012 while I was patrolling the Brown Bridge Road area I had just checked two vehicles at River Side Grocery, then headed west bound on Browns Bridge Road when I reached the four way stop I turned back around east bound on Browns Bridge Road. As I was heading back towards River Side Grocery I noticed a vehicle heading west bound, and that the vehicle had its bright light's on. As the vehicle passed me I turned around going to administer a traffic stop on it for failure to dim head lights. Failure to dim head lights is an indicator for someone under the influence of drugs or alcohol. When the vehicle pulled into the trailer park at 4177 Browns Bridge Road, I turned my blue lights on indicating for the vehicle to stop. The vehicle proceeded up the drive for several yards before stopping. That is another indicator that the subjects in the vehicle were trying to buy more time before stopping due to illegal activities.

When I got out with the vehicle I approached the passenger side and requested to see both the driver and the passengers drivers license. Mr. Jason Southern stated that his license were suspended. When I got back to my vehicle to check their license, a subject later identified as Edward Joseph Garmley, pulled up to my traffic stop on a Cabot ATV. Mr. Garmley got out of the ATV and went up to the vehicle against my orders and began fussing at the subjects inside the car. I advised Mr. Garmley several times to get away from the vehicle before he finally did so. I advised Mr. Garmley to get back into his ATV and to back up beside my patrol car and that I would talk to him after I dealt with the subjects in the car. Mr. Garmley kept telling me that I needed to check the vehicle. Ms. Angela Garmley started to get out of the vehicle while I was talking to Mr. Garmley I advised her to get back in the vehicle and that I would be up there to talk to her in a minute. Ms. Garmley told me that I needed to hurry so she could talk to me. I had Mr. Garmley go sit in his ATV and told him not to speak with the subjects in the vehicle. I had Ms. Garmley get out of the vehicle and asked her where they were coming from and why she only had on one shoe. Ms. Garmley stated they were coming from a friends house and she had got stung on the foot, and that's why Mr. Southern was driving the vehicle. When I asked Mr. Southern where they came from, he stated a friends house and that Ms. Garmley had something wrong with her foot so he was driving her home. While I was talking to Mr. Southern, Mr. Garmley started arguing with Ms. Garmley. I flashed my light at him two different times, and Mr. Garmley proceeded to argue with her. I placed Mr. Garmley under arrest for Obstruction of an officer.

I noticed that when Ms. Garmley stepped out of the vehicle she stumbled slightly, I also noticed that Ms. Garmley had slurred speech, which let me to believe that she was on some sort of illegal drug. I asked Ms. Garmley if she had used any illegal drugs or if there was any illegal drugs inside the vehicle. Ms. Garmley stated no she hasn't done any nor was there anything illegal in the vehicle. Mr. Southern was placed under arrest for driving on suspended license.

I asked Ms. Garmley if I could run my dog around her vehicle to assure me that there wasn't anything illegal in the vehicle. She stated it was fine I could search the vehicle if I wanted. I then had Ms. Garmley get the two children out of the vehicle and step away from the vehicle. I got my K-9, Ruhl, out of my patrol car and started my search at the back driver's side tail light. On my first time around the vehicle Ruhl had shown enhanced sniffing and a change of body posture at the driver's side front tire and front lower part of the door. On my second pass by the driver's side, Ruhl, struck his head inside the driver's window and alerted by change in body posture and enhanced sniffing.

training with Ruhl at the South Georgia K-9 school, I was certain that his alert was true. Marsha Peavy had shown me a couple magnetic boxes that subjects are using to hide their drugs under their vehicle. Marsha Peavy is the instructor at the South Georgia K-9. I remember what she had told me so I looked up under the vehicle and located a small metal Camel Snus can stuck to the front of the vehicle right under the driver's door. I retrieved the can from under the car and when I opened it there were small corner bags with a crystal substance believed to be Methamphetamine inside of it along with a large round magnet.

I asked Ms. Garmley if it belonged to her she stated no. Due to the vehicle belonging to Ms. Garmley and Mr. Southern driving it both subjects were charged with possession of Meth. Also Mr. Southern was charged with driving on suspended license, and failure to dim head lights. The vehicle was turned over to A&R Wrecker. Also Ms. Garmley had \$1800.00 cash in her purse she stated that Mr. Garmley gave to her for child support. I asked Mr. Garmley if that was so and he stated yes, in the past week and a half he had given her \$ 3400.00.

Ms. Garmley stated this was a set up and that the dope was not hers. I advised her that it was in her possession and that she would have to speak with the Judge and a lawyer. Deputy Joe Wilkey transported Mr. Garmley to the Sheriff's Dept. Deputy Darrel Summey transported Mr. Southern to the Sheriff's Dept, and I transported Ms. Garmley to the Sheriff's Dept.
