

In order to obtain the cost to taxpayers of the proposals found in “Moving America Forward,” the 2012 Democratic National Platform, only proposals with legislative history were included. The cost estimates come from independent sources such as the Congressional Budget Office, the text of the bill itself and the White House’s own figures, and consider new spending and increases over existing spending.
