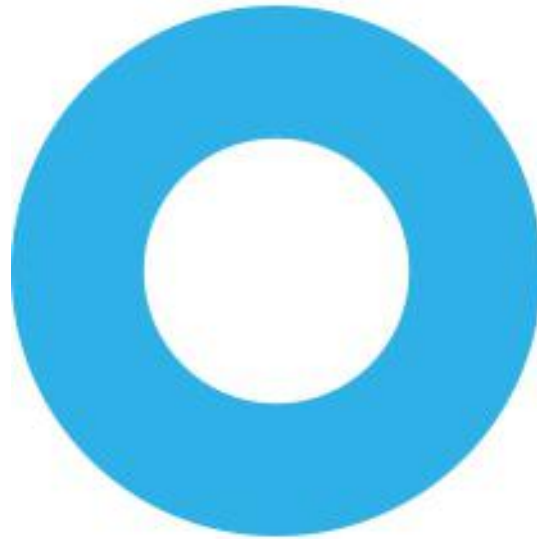

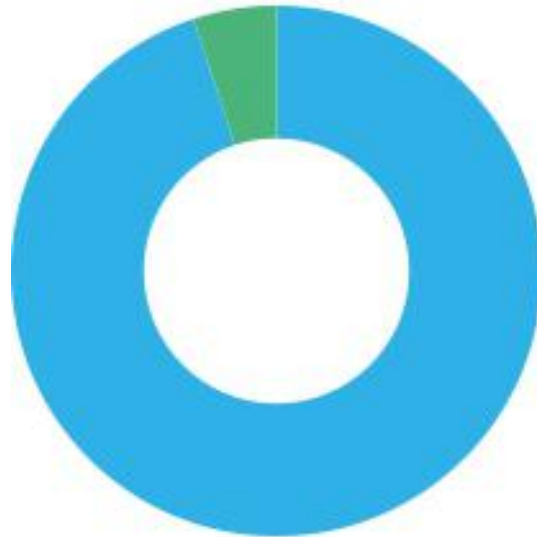

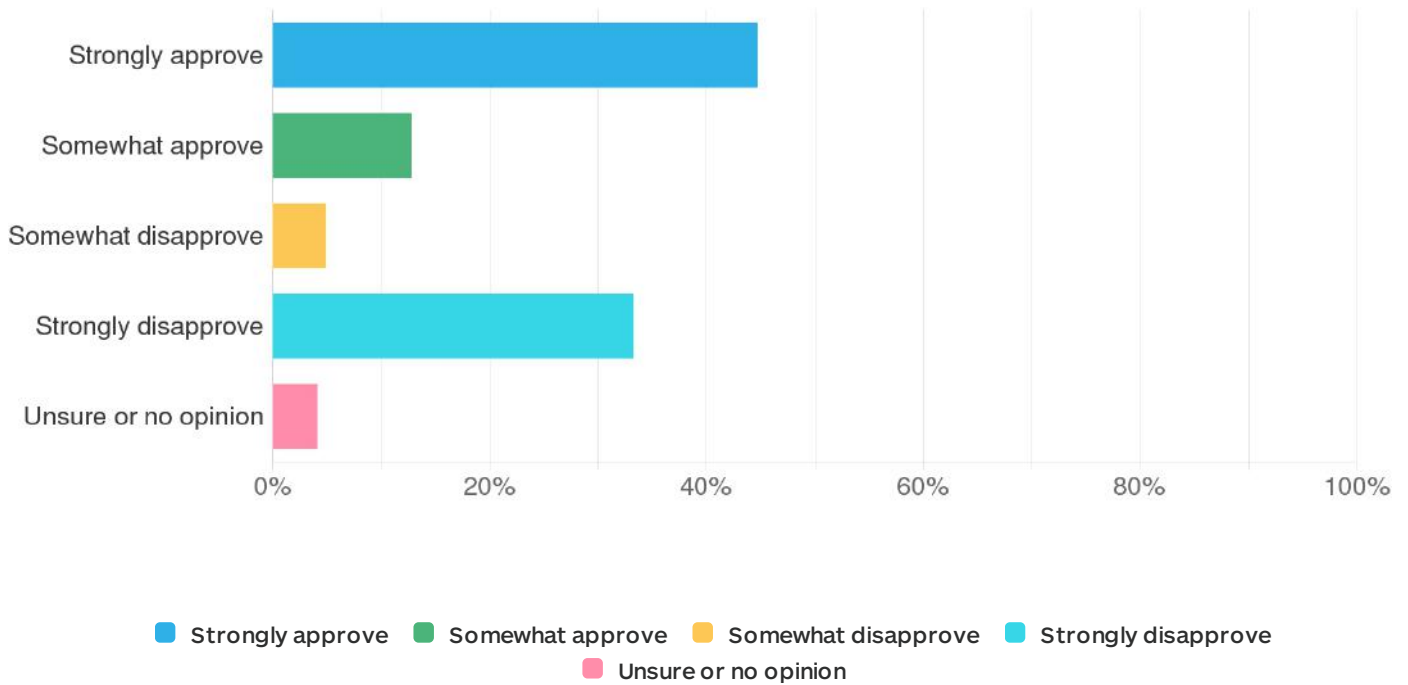

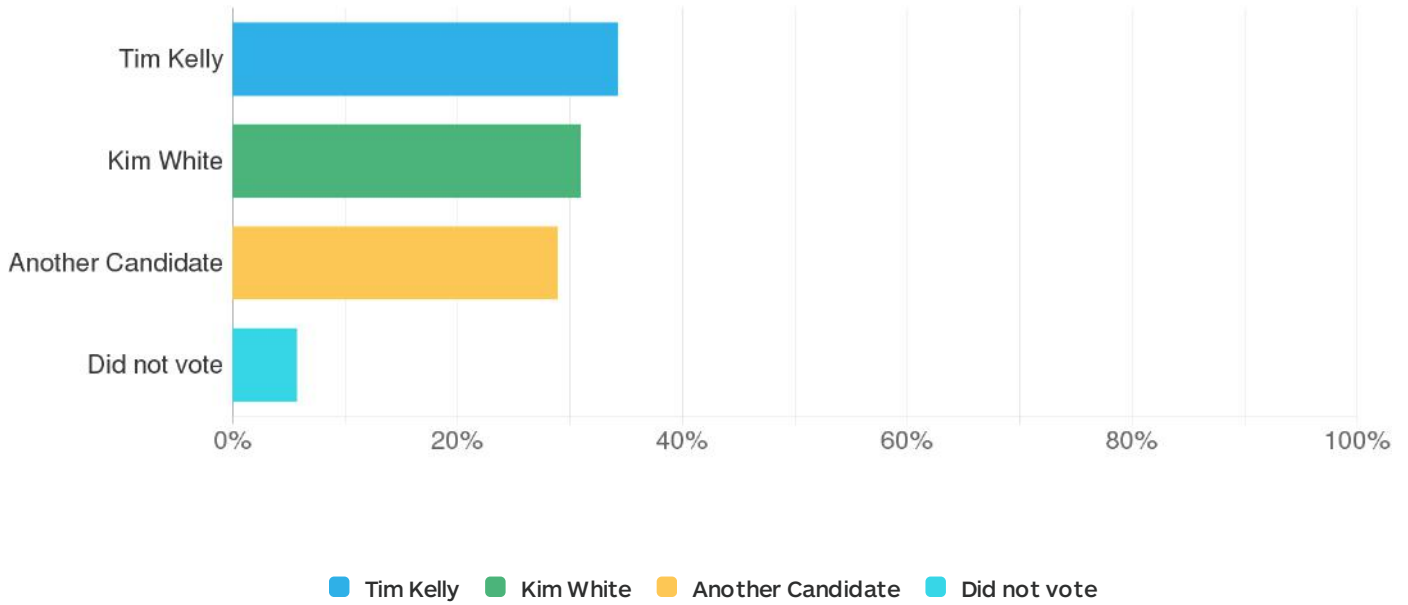

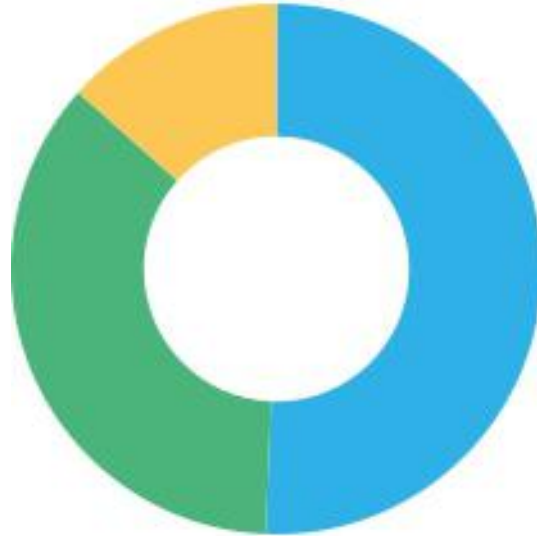

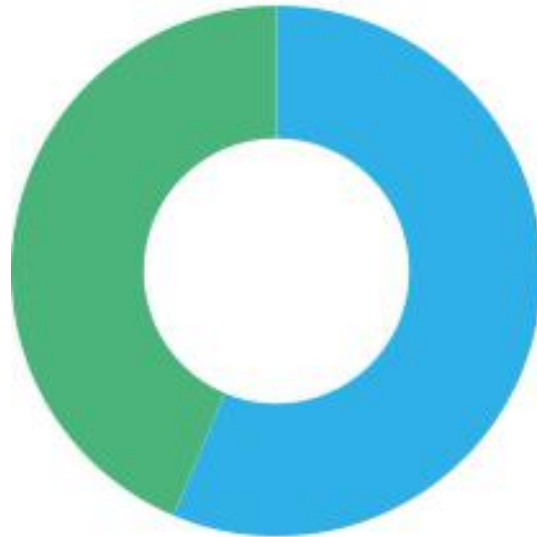

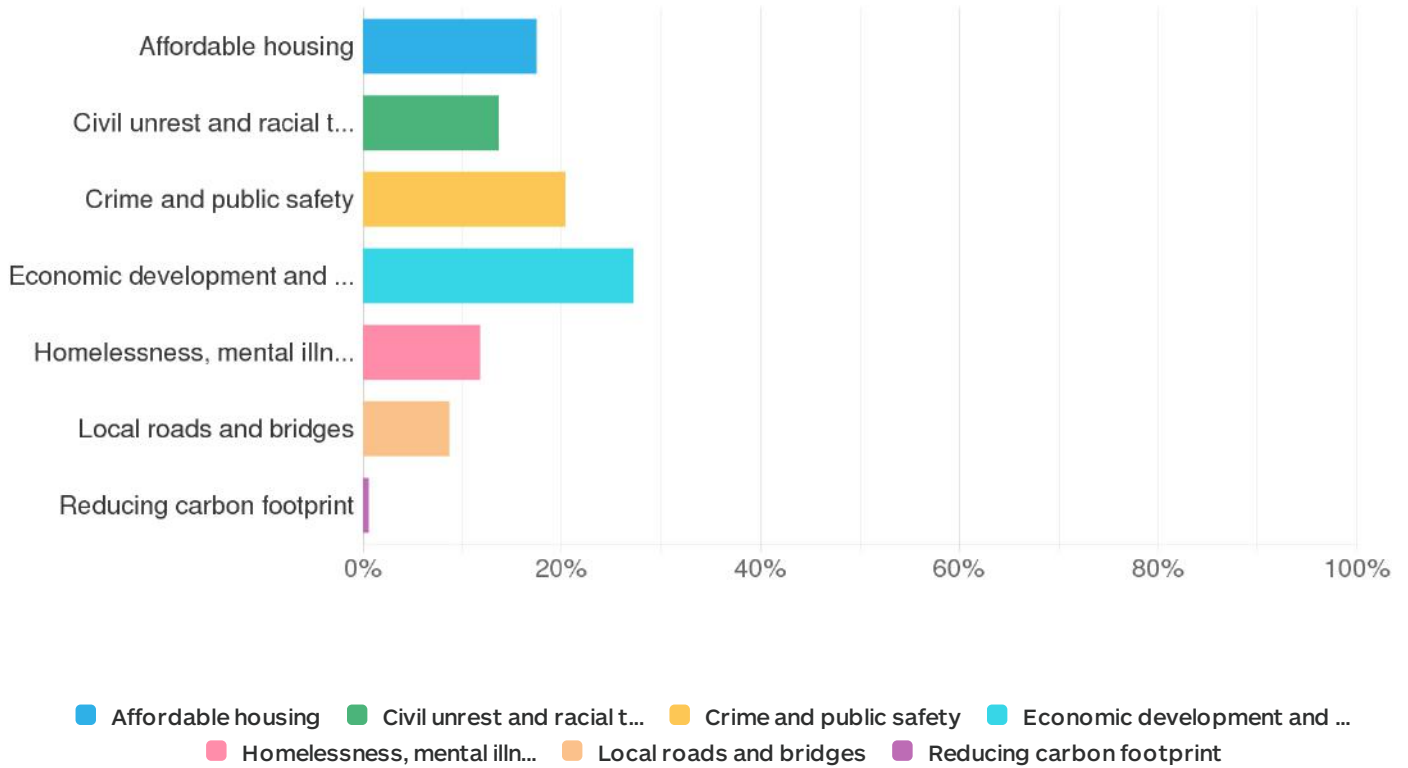

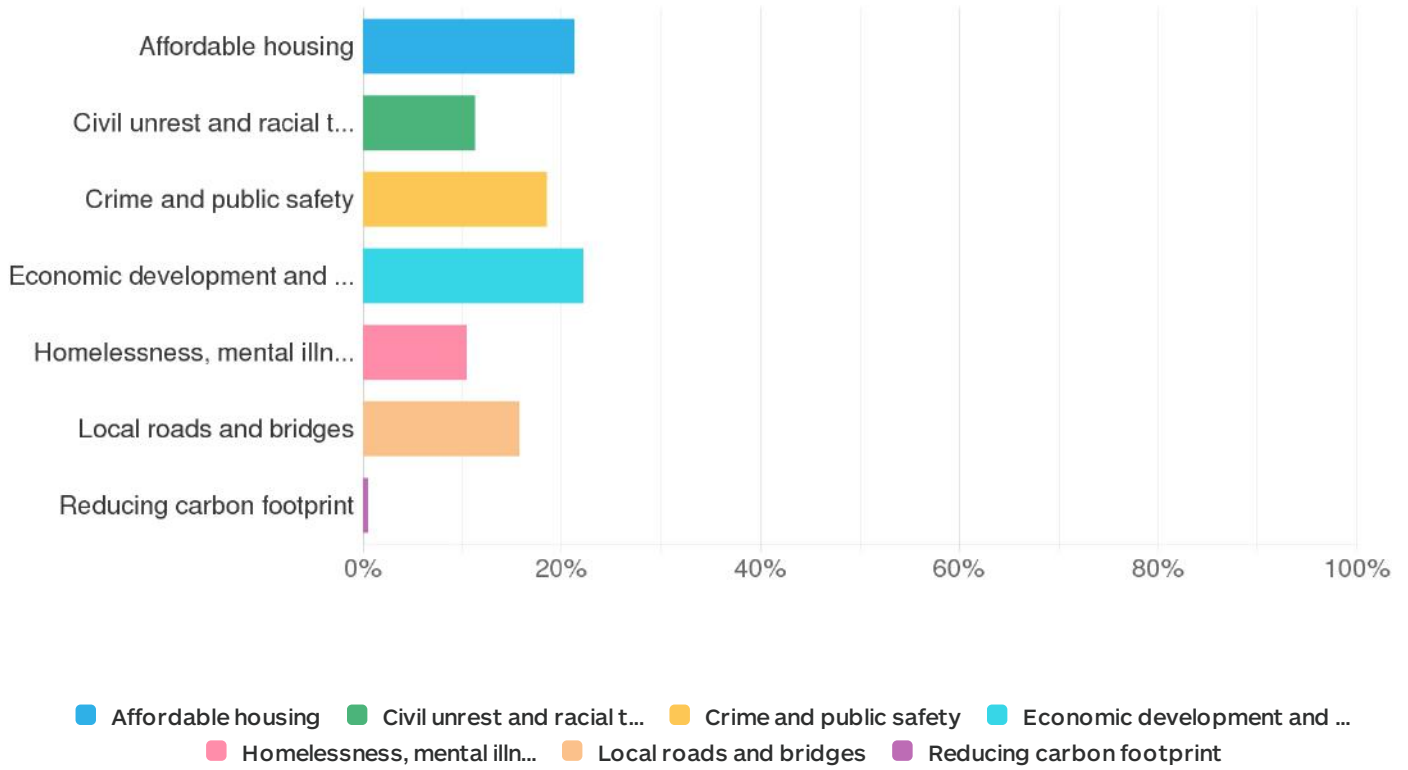

When thinking ahead to 2021, which of the following do you believe is the 2nd most important issue the city of Chattanooga faces?

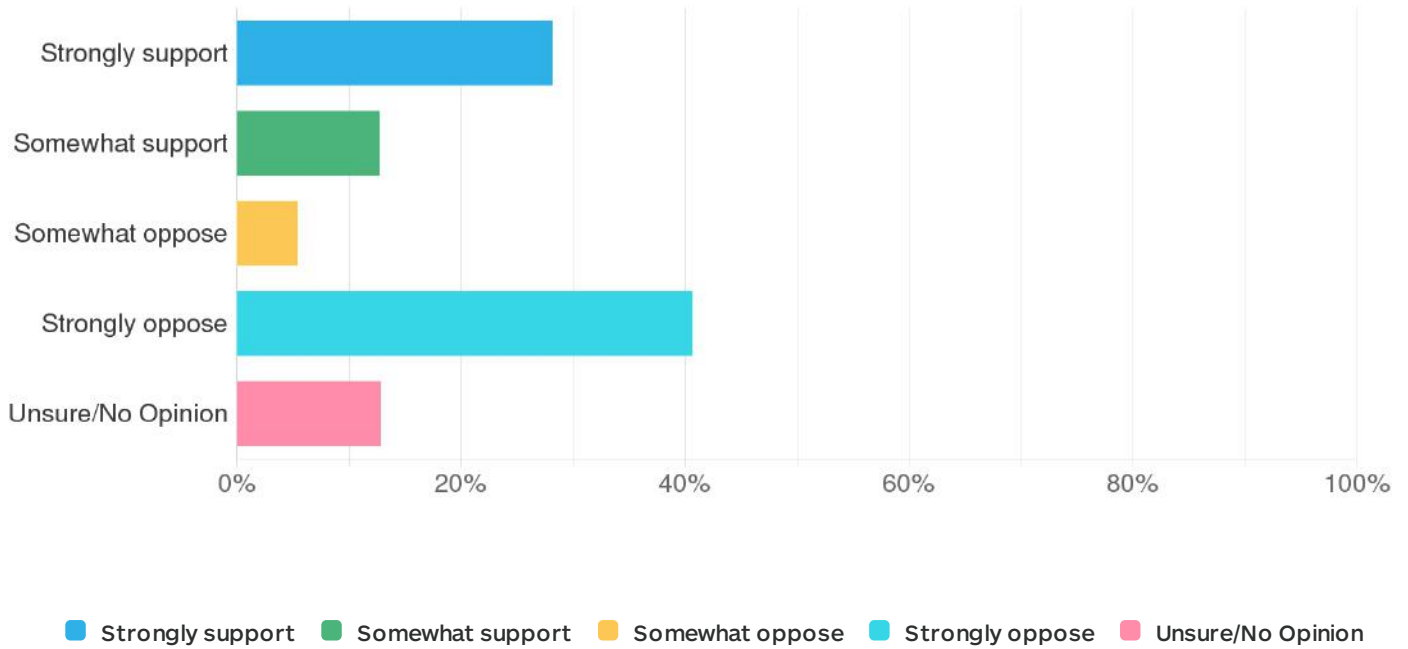

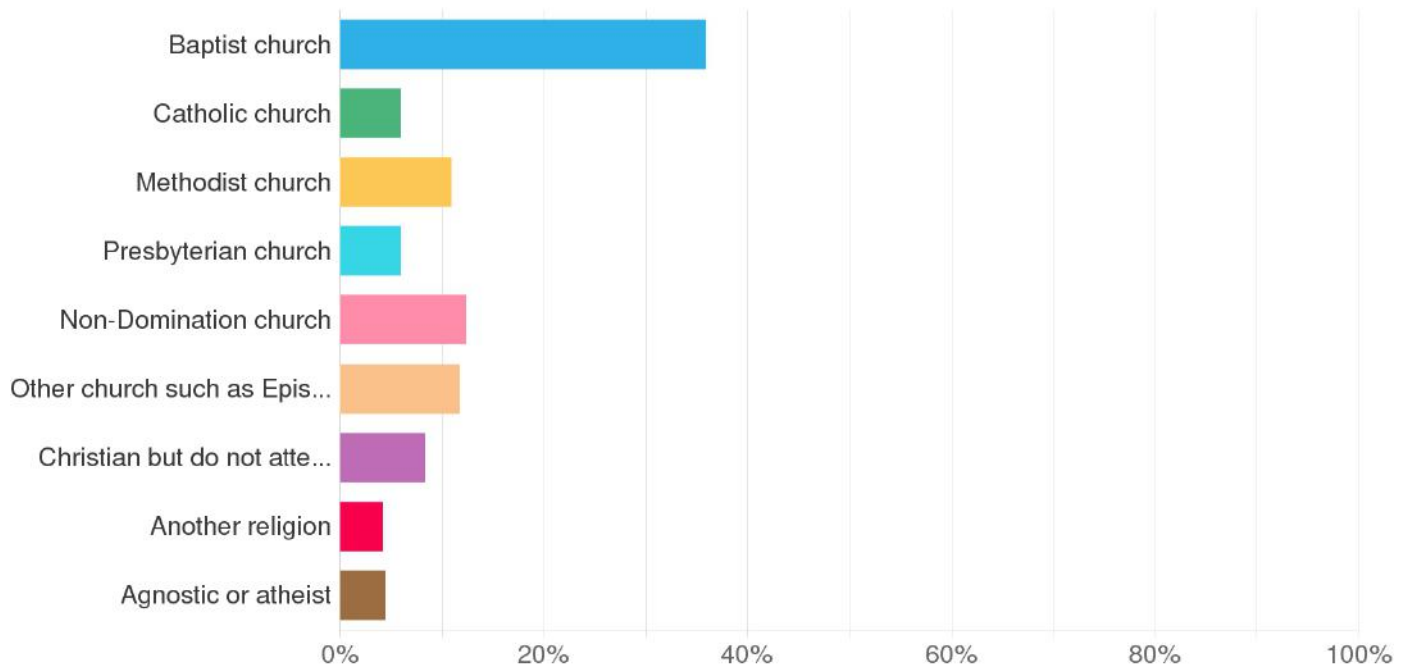

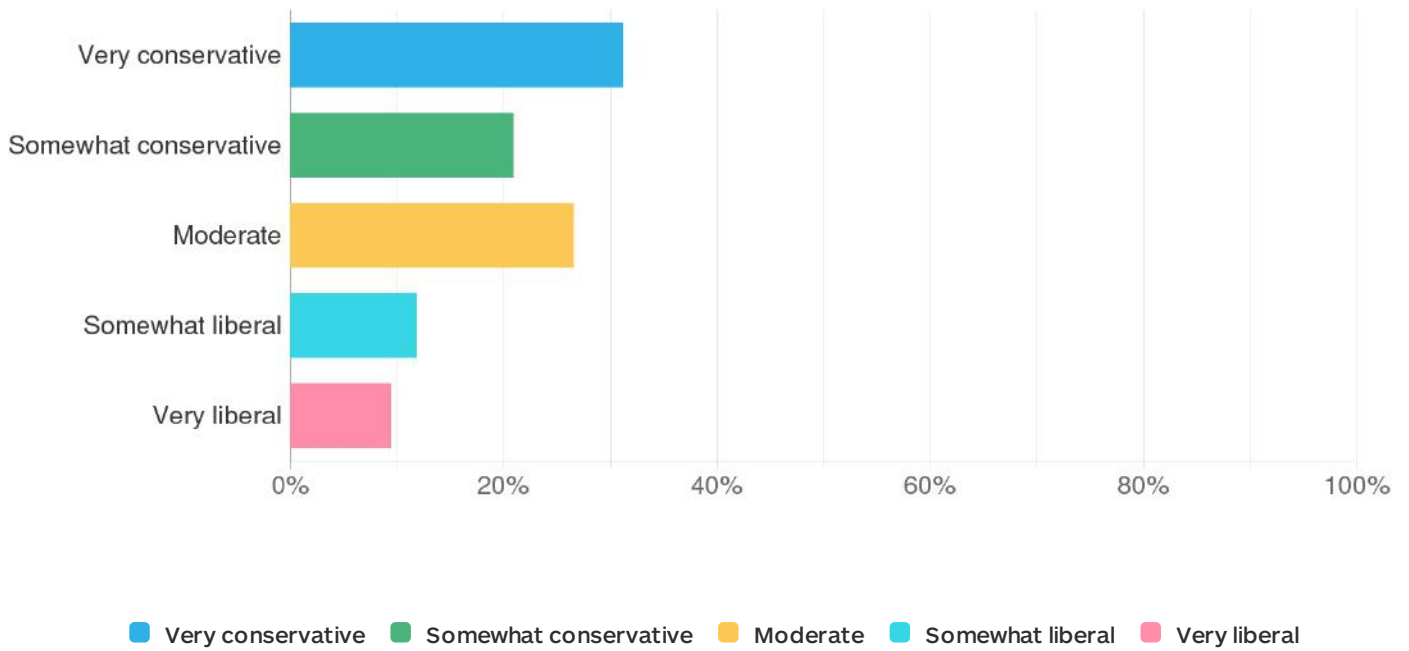

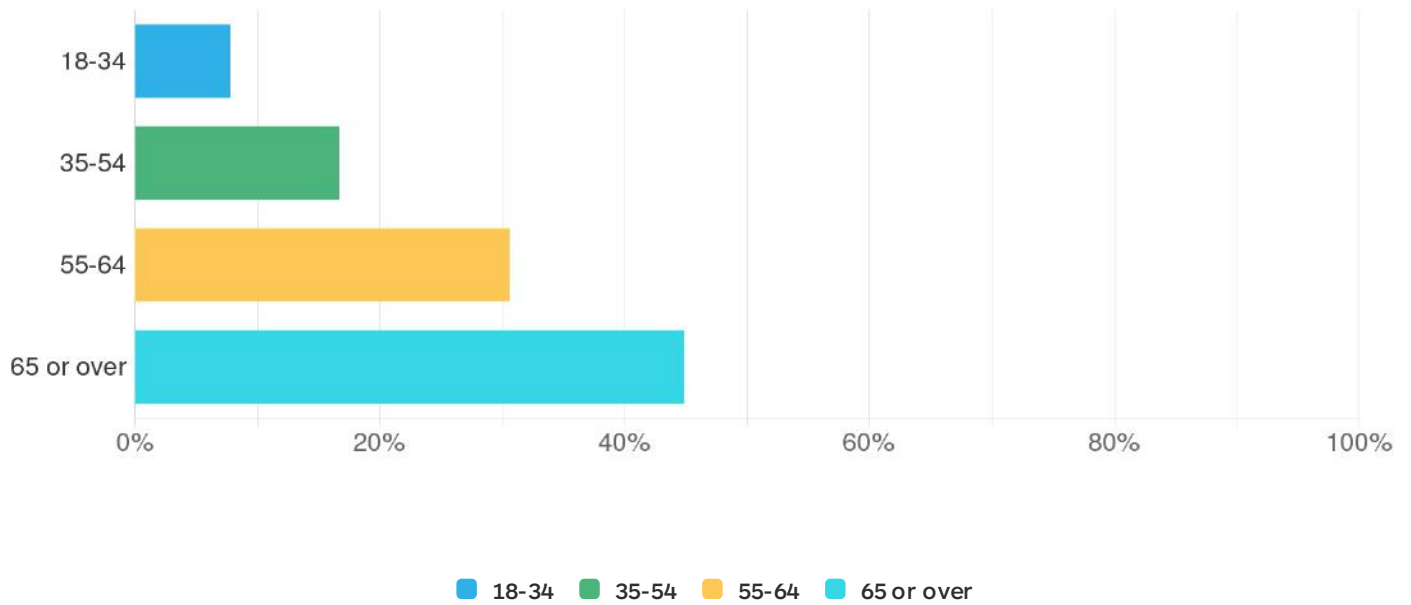

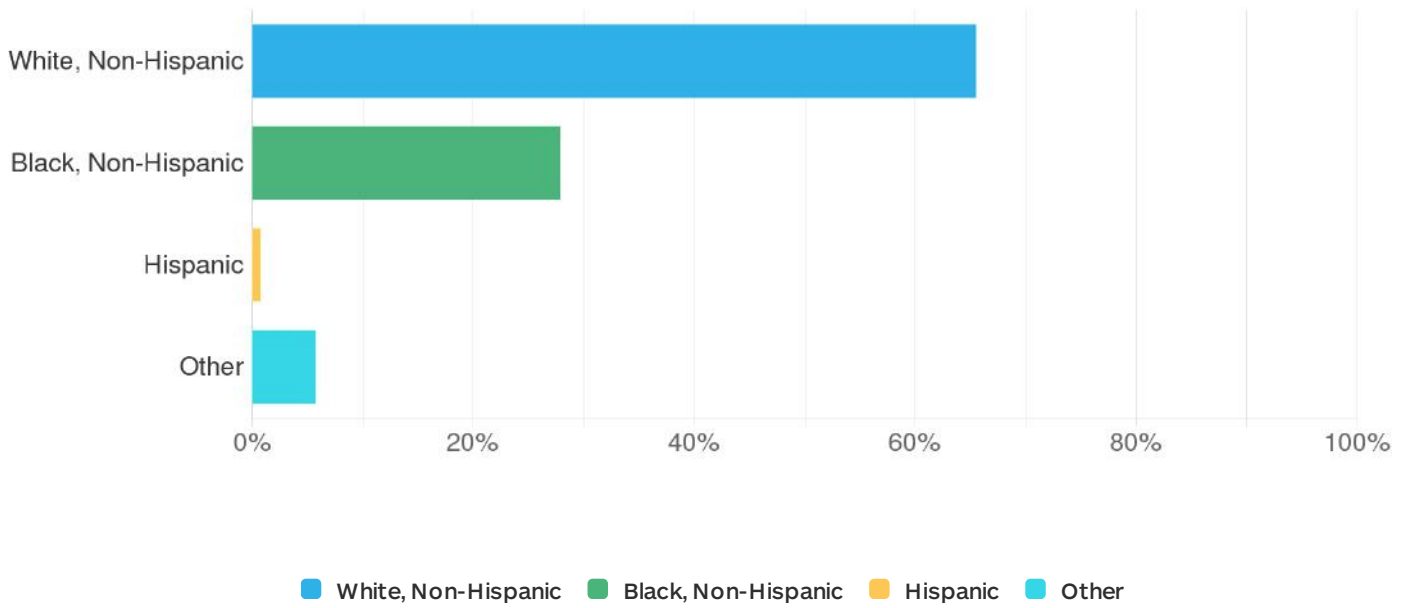

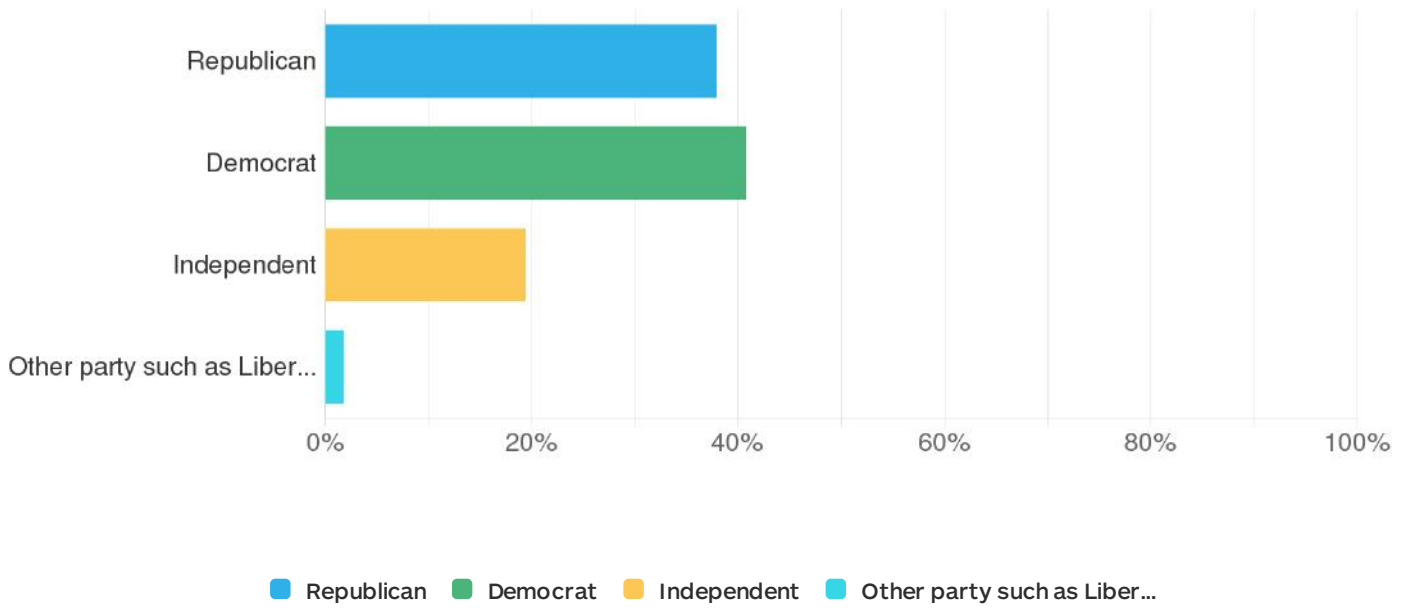

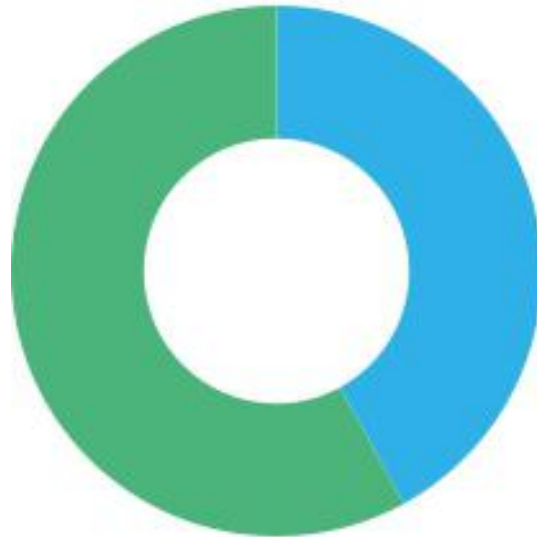

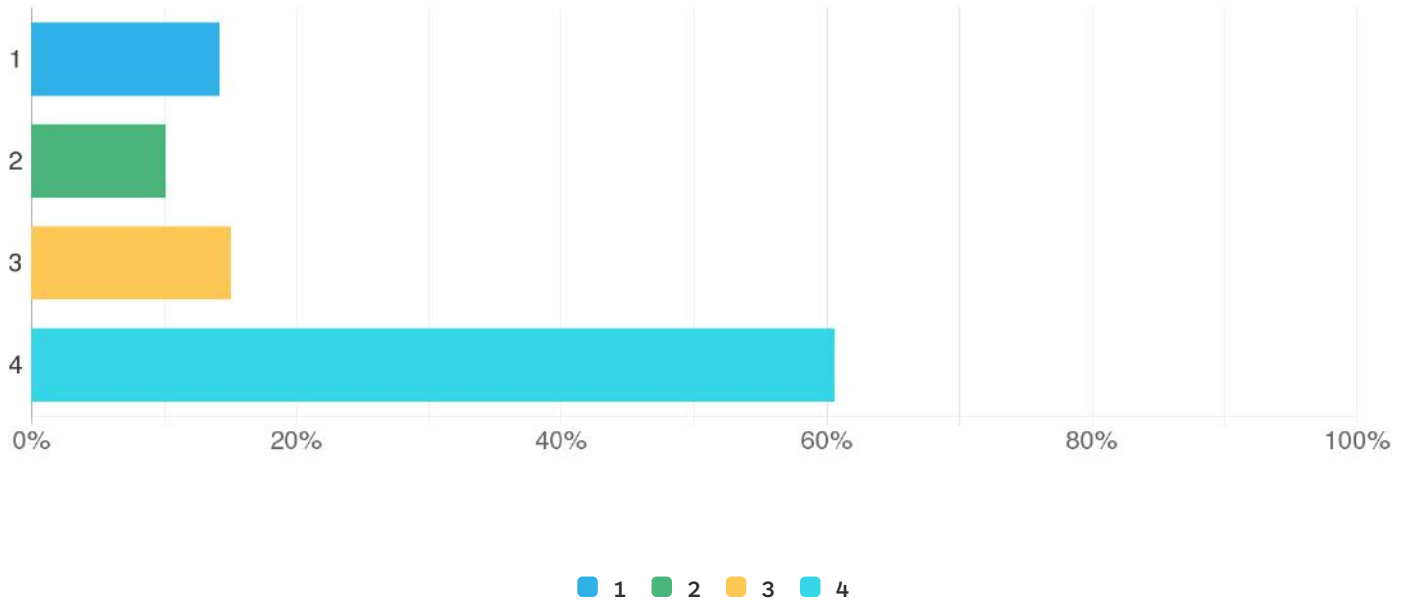

The TN Chattanooga Mayoral Runoff Benchmark Survey was conducted by Spry Strategies and combined Landline and Mobile Interviews from March 25 - March 26 among a random sample of 330 likely voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.3 percentage points. The sample polled voters who voted in at least 2 of 3 mayoral general elections in 2009, 2013, & 2017. Results are weighted using the general election turnout model. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.
